REFRACTION FEE AUTHORIZATION

Refraction is the measurement of the optical system of the eye to determine the need for glasses and/or contact lenses. A refraction measurement determines the power of the lens needed in order to provide you with the clearest possible vision. Our office recommends getting a refraction once a year or if you feel your vision has changed.

The majority of health insurances no longer cover the checking and updating of your eyeglass prescription known as the "Refraction." The patient is responsible for the refraction fee in addition to any deductible or co-payment charge. If you wish to have your eyeglasses checked and your prescription updated, please inform the front desk at check-in. There is a charge of \$20 for this service if it is not covered by your insurance.
